Device grounds (GND)

Question:

Are my AiM device grounds distinguished by type?

Answer:

AiM devices grounds (GND) are distinguished by type. Considering this, the wirings supplied follow the same criteria.

Depending on devices and their functions, can be distinguished:

- Main power ground
- Grounds for digital signals and data lines (RPM, USB, Speed, Lap, K-line, RS232), in common with the power ground
- Specific analog input grounds, isolated from the ones described above. These are included in the analog channels cables labelled "CH #" and they are linked to the PIN 2 of each analog input.
